The Artists Archives of the Western Reserve (AAWR) announces the second annual *Western Reserve Open Photography Competition* to be held at the Beachwood Branch of the Cuyahoga County Library, opening on November 1, 2014.

Submission Information

The AAWR invites photographers to participate and submit images using any photographic process (silver gelatin, digital print, alternative process, etc.) Experimental and mixed techniques are welcome. Only two dimensional work is eligible for admission. All entries must be submitted online via Smarter Entry at www.artistsarchives.org

Note: All accepted prints must be **professionally framed**, wired and ready for hanging. **Size limitation for work (including frame) is 20 x 24 inches.** The AAWR retains the right to refuse any work not presented in a professional manner.

Eligibility

The Call for Entries is open to both amateur and professional photographers.

Entry Fee

The entry fee is \$25 for the first 3 images. Additional images may be submitted at \$10 per image. There is no limit on additional images. AAWR will take a 30% commission on any sales.

Opening Reception: Saturday, November 1st, 10:00 AM. A panel discussion consisting of the award winners will follow the Awards Presentation.

Awards will be presented in five categories:

Best in Show: \$400

Best Black and White: \$200

Best Color: \$200

Show Committee Award: \$200

People's Choice: \$200

The **People's Choice Award** will be based on popular vote taken the morning of the opening reception. Come and vote for your favorite photograph. All selected work will be showcased on the AAWR website.

ALL subject matter must be appropriate for PUBLIC VIEWING.

About our Judge:

Diane Waggoner is associate curator in the department of photographs at the National Gallery of Art, Washington. She received a PhD in art history from Yale University. She previously held positions at the Yale University Art Gallery and The Huntington Library, Art Collections, and Botanical Gardens. At the Huntington, she was the curator of *The Beauty of Life: William Morris and the Art of Design* (2003). Since joining the department of photographs at the National Gallery in 2004, she has co-curated *Photographic Discoveries: Recent Acquisitions* (2006), *The Streets of New York: American Photographs from the Collection, 1938-1958* (2006-07), *The Art of the American Snapshot, 1888-1978: From the Collection of Robert E. Jacson* (2007), and *In the Darkroom: Photographic Processes before the Digital Age* (2009). *The Art of the American Snapshot* exhibition catalogue was the 2008 winner of the College Art Association's Alfred H. Barr, Jr., Award for distinguished museum publication. In 2010, she organized *The Pre-Raphaelite Lens: British Photography and Painting, 1848-1875*. She is currently collaborating with Tate Britain on *Pre-Raphaelites: Victorian Art and Design, 1848-1900*.

Image Preparation for uploading

To prepare your images for uploading, please adhere to the following image file specifications:

- sRGB or RGB color space (standard)
 -NOT CMYK (typically used by printing industry)
- 72 ppi resolution
- sized to 1,280 pixels on the longest side, the other side width or height proportional
- layers flattened
- 8 bit mode
- JPG format
- JPG compression at level 7 (medium)
- Do not use characters other than a period preceding jpg in the file name.
